

Permissions Guidance

Although this is a non-commercial community project, your film contribution may be shown publicly... so you will need to ensure that anyone featured has given permission for you to film them.

Any music compositions and/or performances will also need permission for use.

Some locations e.g. identifiable National Trust properties will need permission.

Release/Permission forms are not usually necessary:

If filming material in a public place and an individual is illustrative and not named, e.g. street scenes, walkers, crowds etc. As long as there is no invasion of privacy e.g. they are shown in distress, performing in an anti-social or criminal way or if the footage will humiliate or ridicule them.

You will need a release form:

If a person is featured in an interview, demonstration or performance.

Simply print out any of the forms relevant to your film, and fill in as required. Then send them to us along with your film as a complete package.
